

White River MWD OHV Trails

Park Rules (Subject to Revisions)

- Off Highway Vehicles must remain inside the fenced park while riding, and are not allowed to be running up and down the **WRMWD Roads, County Roads, or State Hwy's**
- Helmets, **DOT Approved** are required at **ALL TIMES** when riding **ATV's or Motorcycles. There are no Exceptions.**
- No double riding allowed on ATV's or motorcycles unless designated by manufacturer.
- Factory hardtop or roll cage / rollbar and seatbelts are required for all occupants in SxSs, OHVs, 4x4s.
- Anyone under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian
- Park hours are Sun-up to Sunset, No night Ridding allowed.
- All firearms are prohibited in the OHV park and on the trails (this includes LTC holders) Please leave these in your vehicle at Trail Head.
- No Glass Containers are allowed in the park.
- Alcohol is expressly **FORBIDDEN** on all trails.
- No winching to trees without a tree saver or strap. No winching to fences or gates (Period)
- Overnight camping is not permitted in the OHV Park (Camping is allowed at designated camping areas outside OHV park)
- Pack it In, Pack it Out (Please pick all trash and debris from the trails and your parking area upon leaving.
- Helmets must be worn at all times by ATV / Motorcycle / and any UTV without a designed and attached roof or roll cage system.
- Dangerous operation of any vehicle will not be tolerated
- Stay on existing marked trails – **NO TRAIL BLAZING**
- Larger vehicles yield to smaller vehicles
